**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WEST METRO FIRE
PROTECTION DISTRICT IN SUPPORT OF THE REFERRED MEASURE APPEARING ON
THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 BALLOT**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the West Metro Fire Protection District (the "District") passed a resolution that submitted a ballot issue to the District's electorate for the November 6, 2018 coordinated election; and

WHEREAS, referred Ballot Issue 7C requests that the electorate allow the District to adjust its mill levy to offset revenue lost due to changes in the residential assessment rate pursuant to the provisions of the Gallagher Amendment within the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Ballot Issue 7C is crucial to the future of the District and the general health, welfare, and safety of its inhabitants and taxpayers by ensuring that the District maintains a reliable level of funding to continue providing adequate staffing as well as the necessary training and equipment to protect and serve the community at the highest standard; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 1-45-117(1)(b)(III)(A), C.R.S., the Board may adopt a resolution taking a position of advocacy on any issue that it has referred to the electorate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WEST METRO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT:

1. The Board hereby unanimously and enthusiastically supports Ballot Issue 7C and urges the voters of the District to vote "Yes" on Ballot Issue 7C at the November 6, 2018 election.
2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption by this Board. Pursuant to § 1-45-117(1)(b)(III)(B), C.R.S., the passage of this Resolution may be reported, and this Resolution may be distributed, through established, customary means, other than paid advertising, by which information about other proceedings of this District are regularly provided to the public.
